LOOK AT WHAT IS RIGHT IN FRONT OF US

As the warmer climate is upon us, we all are slowly stepping outside and dipping our toe in the sunlight. We gaze across the landscape and out into the water, hoping to catch a glimpse of a passing sailboat or other watercraft vessel. As a newcomer to the area, I am continuously humbled by Plattsburgh and Lake Champlain. For example, right outside our patio door, if you look slightly to the right, there is an unassuming island called Crab Island. It may only catch your eye for a second as our eyes dominantly prefer the rippling waters. Let's step back for a moment and reflect on this historical landscape. Crab island is the site of a 50-foot granite obelisk built in 1908, more familiarly called the Soldiers and Sailors Monument. This monument and Crab Island's history dates to 1814 when Commodore Thomas Macdonough, an American Captain in the U.S. Navy born in Delaware, lined his fleet across the waters to Cumberland Head in anticipation of catching the British as they sailed from the North and directly through the sight lines of Lake Forest. The Commodore was victorious in this endeavor, which is noted as a "decisive battle in American History" as it prevented the invasion and conquest of New York State by the British. Today, Crab Island is managed by the NYS Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation.

In the coming weeks, I suggest we toast to Crab Island and all those that lost their lives in the pursuit of peace. Peace and tranquility have become a stock phrase these days. Lake Forest has the benefit of a daily reminder of the struggles incurred before our time. I am curious to know how many residents and staff have stepped foot on Crab Island. Please share any personal photos of Crab Island and/or photos of Lake Forest taken from Crab Island. I would also be interested in learning more about this history from anyone willing to share.
